This context extended from section 1 to section 2 narrowing as it approached section 2 (see notebook & plan for sketches). After rain it became apparent that the wall section 2 trench did not narrow between section 1 + 2. This was not discovered until after removing what may have been 0804 above 0762 (see SM notebook for further explanation).
