DESCRIPTION Wall that stands for 6 courses, not regular; it was built with cleaved medium stones and bonded with soil. The nucleus is made of soft soil, little stones and fragments of tiles. Now it's possible to see only the S. side, because of the border of the excavation. Height 30 cm, depth 65 cm, and length 4 m. This wall was built better than the walls 256 & 173, but we can't say now if it's from another phase.

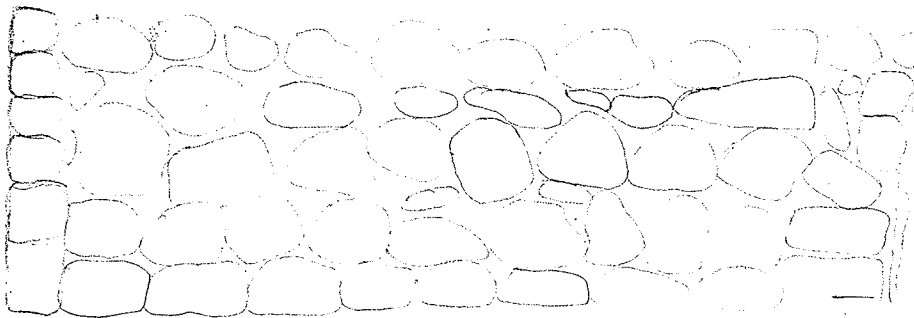
