<p>Wall that is present in the middle of the room 21. This wall had been the N wall of the first phase of the room, and it was broken when they decided to have a larger room. It's a wall with the external face (N&S) made of ^{limestone} medium stones (e.e. cm. 23x20x10) and a nucleus made of pale broken soil and little stones, fragments of tiles and fragments of pottery. It's possible to see just one course. The joints aren't evident, just 1 cm and in some times the stones are one near the other.</p>

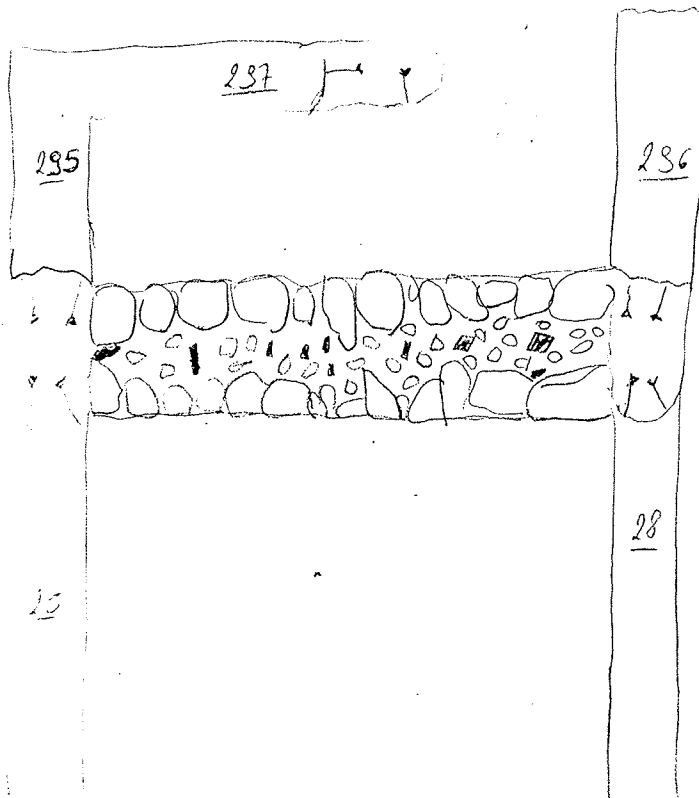
