Northern wall of room 21, it's possible to see only the southern external face and the nucleus, because the modern trench (173) has cut it on the north side. The southern side is preserved at w. for 4 courses, but going east it's broken. The masonry, however, stands for 4 courses, built in a sub-orthogonal line. The height max. preserved is 0,70m. The joints aren't eroded (1cm) and the bond is a pale brown sandy soil. This wall was built after breaking the wall 274 as the new northern border wall of the room 21.
