The S side is built with squared stones, measur. 45 x 20 cm., built in 2 courses and a course of smaller stones, h. 10 cm., and then other 2 courses with stones of h. 20 cm. It is abutted by US 263 where there should be a jamb of a door.

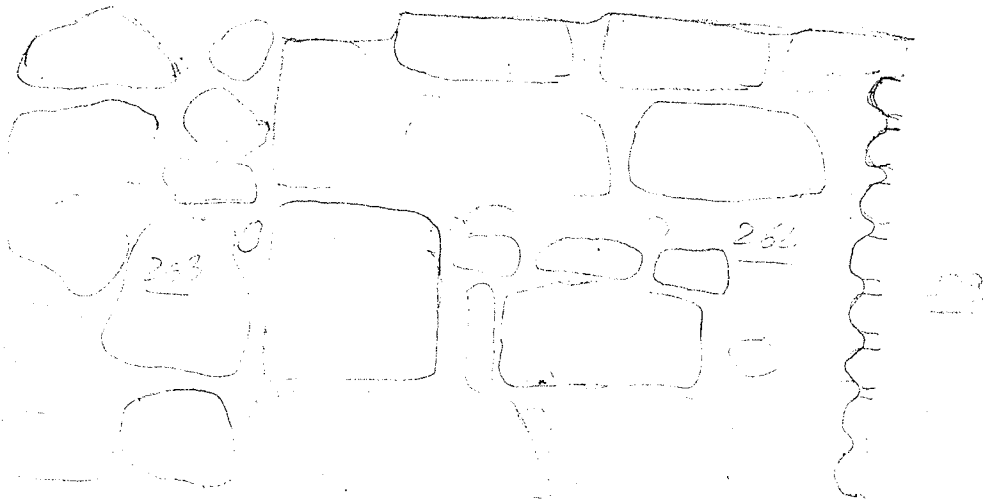
