DESCRIPTION						
Eastern wall of the room 21. This wall has 2 external faces (N&S) made of medium stones (20 x 15 cm.) and a nucleus made of pale brown sandy soil, little stones and fragments of tiles. It has an amogeneous structure and it's preserved for 3 courses built in a sub-orientated line. The height max. preserved is 76 cm. The orientated joints are evident (3 cm.) as the vertical ones (2 cm.) This wall was built after breaking the wall 274 and abuts to the wall 28.

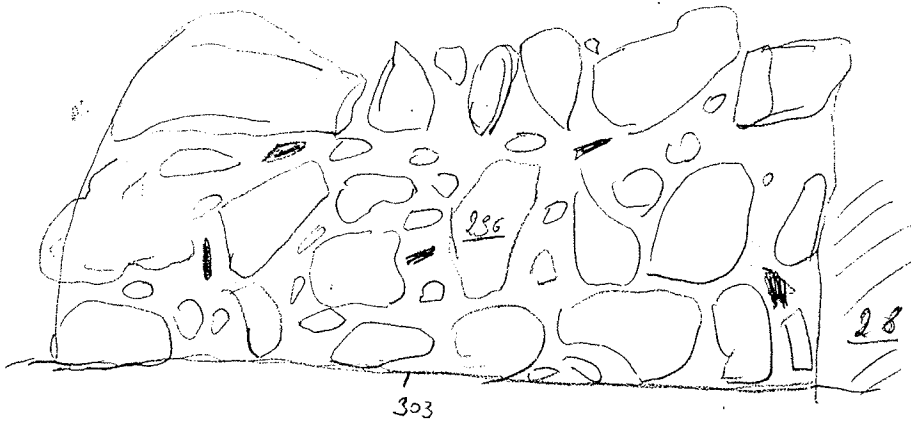
