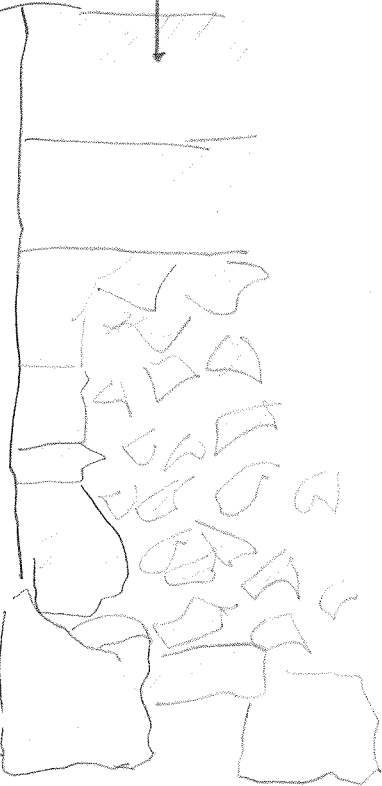


Staircase
