This operation has the purpose of defining the area of the 6th B.C. sanctuary. Level 3 = area down to pavement. Level 4 = Area below pavement. Plan is to take area down only to the level of pavement. When pavement does not appear deeper excav. will be carried out to search for pavement. Also plan to define apparent entrance of structure to the west. Material is predom. coarse sand w/ some frags. of black glaze pottery. Pavement has appeared in interior of structure as expected.



The Western entrance still is not def. but work on off. day should clarify set.

Large area around "Pit 2" does not yet show pavement. Further work tomor. should reveal it.

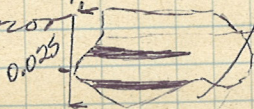

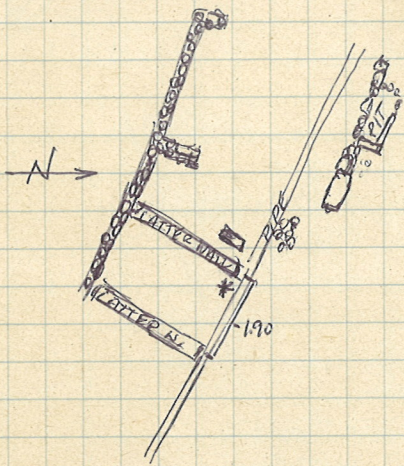

East of latter wall running perpendicular of South 6th wall SAMPLE IN A GRAY CLAY MATRIX w/ STREAKS OF REDDISH SAND; ROOTLETS PRESENT. Pottery is all of very fine ^{friable} orange coarseware, most appears to be from a fairly large bowl, one rim fragment from a smaller cup or bowl with interior glaze and linear ^{decor.} design on exterior
