Moderate amount of frank blood present.</p> <p>Respiratory: Diffuse congestion and hemorrhage within the down lung.</p> <p>Cardiovascular: Multiple fibrinous adhesions between the pericardium and heart were observed. <p>Hepatic mass with probable seeding of the serosal cavity (ie: carcinomatosis likely). Mass had ruptured leading to blood in the abdomen and likely was the underlying cause for the sudden decline. Severe emaciation likely indicates chronicity and cachexia.</p>

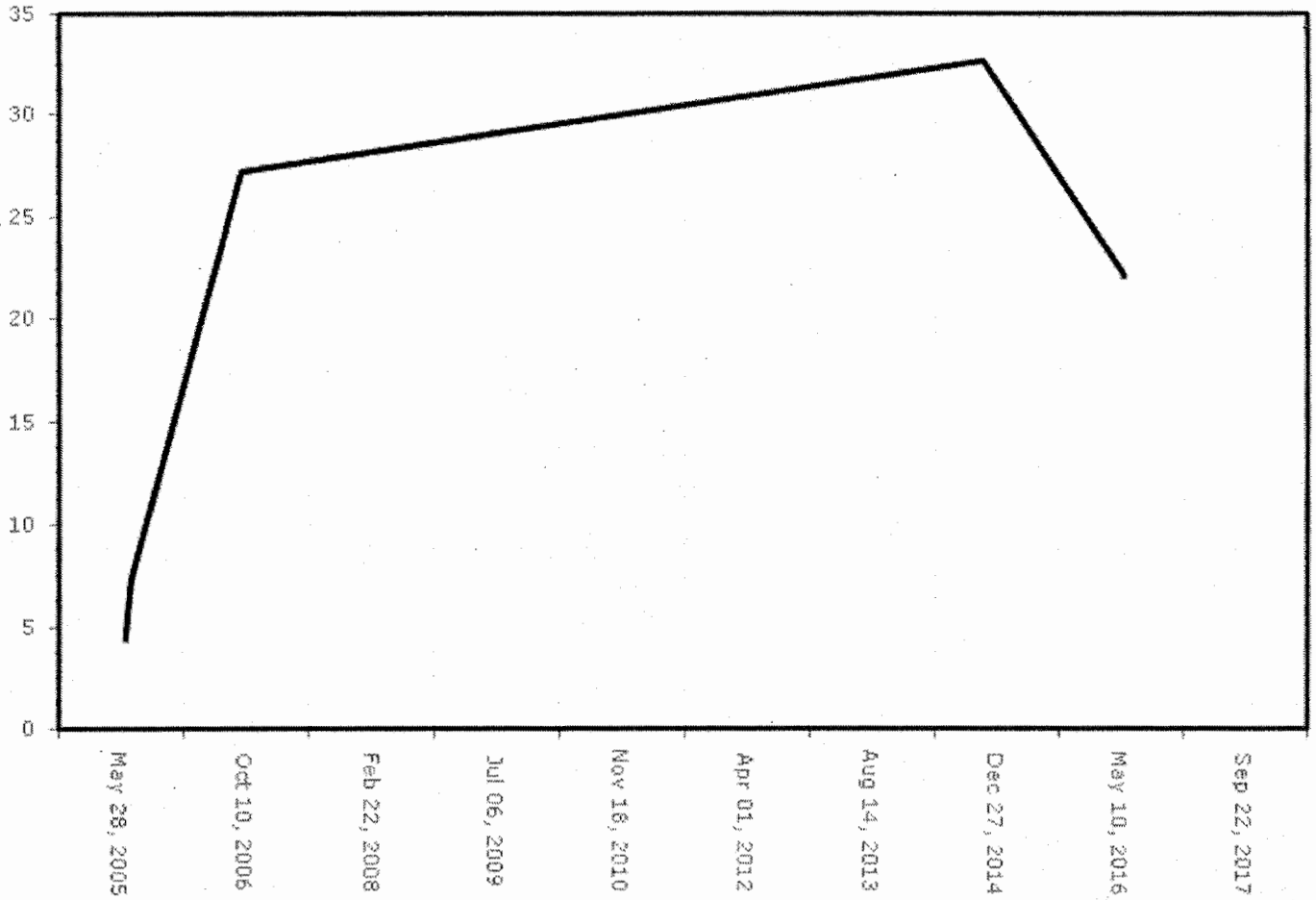

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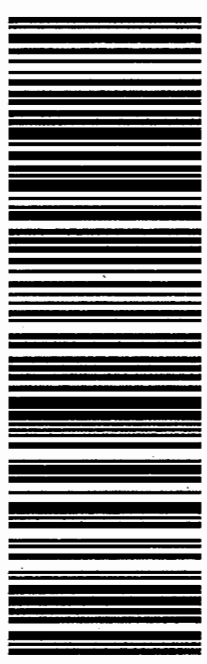
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
