B. THE VALIDITY OF THIS PERMIT IS ALSO CONDITIONED UPON STRICT OBSERVANCE OF ALL APPLICABLE FOREIGN, STATE, LOCAL OR OTHER FEDERAL LAW.

C. VALID FOR USE BY PERMITTEE NAMED ABOVE.

D. Authorized to take/receive/possess/transport not to exceed two (2) of each species of migratory birds, not to exceed fifty (50) specimens per year total.

E. Authorized to salvage migratory birds found dead in which the permittee had no part in the death or killing thereof.

F. Permittee MUST also comply with all standard conditions of Scientific Collecting/Salvage Permit "Attachment I". Said attachment is a condition of this permit and shall remain attached hereto at all times.

"ATTACHMENT I"

IN ADDITION TO SPECIFIC PERMIT CONDITIONS AS NOTED ON FEDERAL FISH AND WILDLIFE PERMIT, FORM 3-201, PERMITTEE(S) MUST COMPLY WITH STANDARD CONDITIONS LISTED BELOW.

1. Not authorized to take OR live-trap and release eagles and/or federally listed endangered/threatened species.
2. Any endangered/threatened species and/or bald or golden eagles salvaged, if salvage activities are authorized, must be reported to issuing office within 48 hours at (505) 766- 2091.
3. Not authorized to take, live-trap and release and/or salvage specimens on federal refuge lands without additional written authorization from the Division of Refuges and Wildlife.  
  
Not authorized to trespass and/or collect on State wildlife refuges or Federal reserves, or other public and private property without permit/permission from landowner or custodian.
4. Live specimens not suitable for release must be deposited with a specific public educational/scientific institution as specified in 50 CFR 21.12(b), or as directed by issuing office.
5. Dead specimens unsuitable/for the research or for donation to a public research/educational institution, shall be completely destroyed by burning or burying.
6. Carry and display this permit upon request when conducting any activity authorized herein.
7. Maintain records as required in 50 CFR 13.46.
8. Taking migratory game birds, if authorized by permit, during hunting seasons shall be in compliance with state/federal hunting regulations.
9. Non-toxic steel shot must be utilized where authorized collecting of waterfowl is done with a shotgun.
10. Authorities granted herein shall not be exercised contrary to the laws of the appropriate State agencies.
11. The annual report shall contain copies of reports, publications, or papers on the findings that resulted from the projects.
