Location: MCOL Teaching Collection (E290) with weekly transfers to Ramaley Biology classroom N1B76 (for labs and temporary storage)

Transport the specimens with special care. Keep them submerged in 70% ethanol in the original containers. During class specimens can be taken out of jars, but they need to be kept moist with same ethanol solution (ideally overlain with ethanol moistened paper towels). Please put specimens back in container as soon as possible to eliminate air drying. Please do not use of water in place of 70% ethanol. The instructors may dissect larger-size fish to a small extent as far as they maintain their physical integrity. Please keep specimens in a locked fireproof cabinet while not in use.
