**Purpose:** Examination of ontological ossification of parafrontal bones in sphaerodactylid geckos

Prior to C&S preparation, record snout-vent length, body and tail length, sex, and reproductive condition (if possible). The skin and viscera, including stomach contents, should be returned to UCM in vials, properly labeled with the name and catalog number of the associated specimen. Other types of destructive analysis or tissue sampling are not permitted without the Collection Manager's prior approval.
