7693	Tomoceridae	<i>Pogonognathellus</i> sp.	16	Same as 7333
8011	Neanuridae	<i>Sensillanura</i> sp. ? (white)	1	All of these have to be mounted to make accurate and species identifications.

8012	Dicyrtomidae	<i>Ptenothrix</i> sp.		Nothing like any west coast species.

May I send you Tomoceridae collected as part of our rapid ecological assessment last summer (URI below)?





