APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO ENTER ALASKA

Note to Applicant: Read all of the instructions on page 4 before filling in this application. In preparing this application, the following instructions will govern:

- 1. Applications will be prepared in quadruplicate, each complete with photograph, affidavit and right-thumb print in the appropriate spaces provided for same.
2. Fingerprint cards will be prepared in duplicate on the standard FBI form and none other.
3. If you prepare this application elsewhere than in the office of Alaska Travel Control, then forward by mail to Alaska Travel Control, 1331 Third Avenue, Seattle, Washington, at least fifteen (15) days before anticipated departure for Alaska.
4. Use typewriter when possible. Complete every entry. The United States Code Annotated, Title 18, Section 80, as amended, provides for a penalty of \$10,000 or imprisonment of not more than ten years or both for making false statements in this application.
5. Special instructions governing preparation of applications for labor and technician recruiting services will be communicated to accredited contractors. The staff of the Alaska Travel Control will assist in the preparation of applications for all persons presenting themselves at the Seattle office. The applicant himself is responsible for the completeness and accuracy of all information given in this application form, notwithstanding the assistance rendered by the staff of Alaska Travel Control or by any other person, organization or agency.

The undersigned hereby applies for permission to enter the Territory of Alaska and submits the following as an inducement for the issuance of a permit:

- (a) I am not an enemy alien or a person of Japanese ancestry.
(b) I am not a person dangerous or potentially dangerous to the military security of the Territory of Alaska.
(c) I am not the wife or a member of the immediate family of an officer or enlisted man of the United States Army, United States Navy or United States Coast Guard stationed in Alaska (except as represented in next paragraph).
(d) If I am the wife or a member of the immediate family of an officer or enlisted man of the United States Army, United States Navy or United States Coast Guard, stationed in Alaska, I represent that I am a bona fide resident of the Territory of Alaska and that my residence there is at the place shown in the attached Affidavit and Agreement which becomes a part of this application. In representing myself to be a bona fide resident of the Territory of Alaska, I do so within the meaning of instruction No. 2 on Page 4 hereof.
(e) If I am the wife or an employable member of the immediate family of a civilian employee of the War or Navy Department stationed in Alaska, or if I am the wife or employable member of the immediate family of an employee of a War or Navy Department contractor operating in Alaska, I represent: (1) That I am a bona fide resident of the Territory of Alaska within meaning of instruction No. 2 on Page 4 hereof, and that my residence there is at the place shown in the attached Affidavit and Agreement which becomes a part of this application; or (2) That I am going to Alaska to accept prearranged employment there as set forth in the attached Affidavit and Agreement which becomes a part of this application. (Check whichever is applicable.)

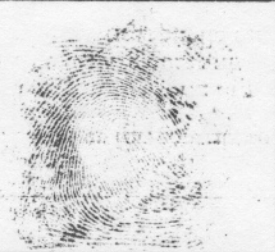

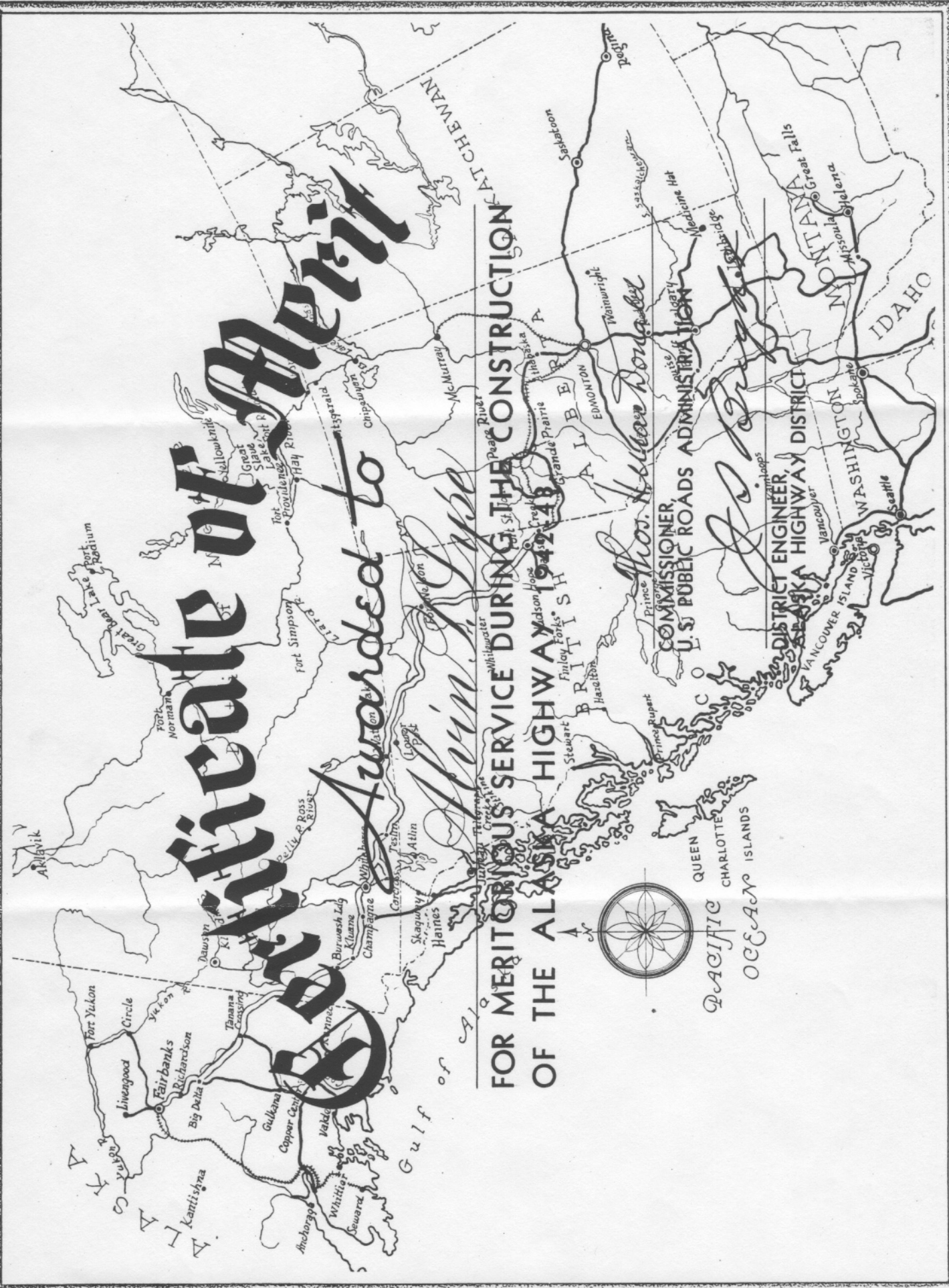
