There are a lot of roots, animal bones and pottery - the roots are either big or small - there are a lot of animal bones including fish - the soil contains a lot of oysters. The layer has not a regular level but descends towards the centre. Near to US 203 (patch of ash) there is a lot of charcoal. This layer is characterized by a lot of tiles and pottery and a few coins dating to the 13th century -
