The S side stands for 150 cm., the N. one for 130 cm. Its depth is 60 cm. At 110 cm. far from the base of use of the room there is the place of the wooden-be as on the other walls of the room (PA 77; PA 156; PA 165). It's not easy understand the sequence with the US 176 because of the cut of the modern trench US 171-173.</p>

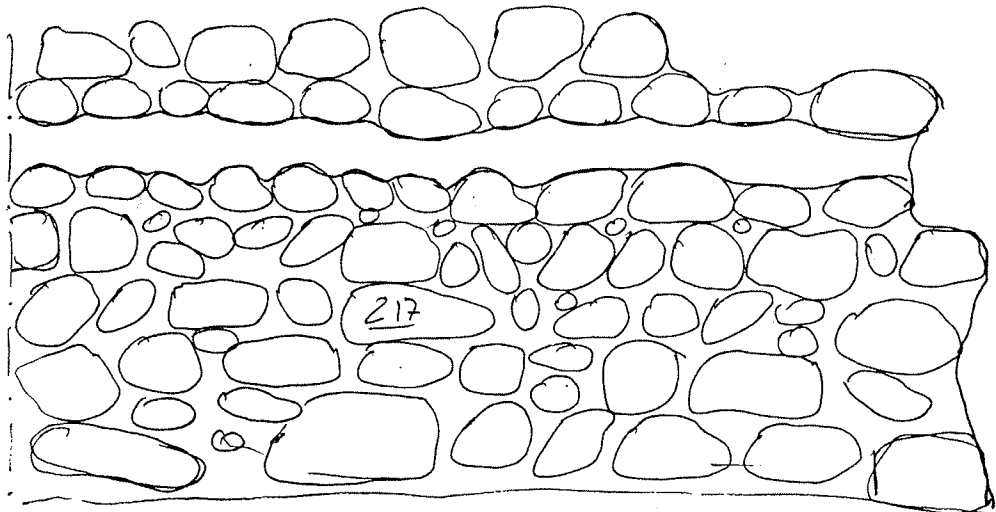
