DESCRIPTION Western wall of the room 21. This wall has the 2 external faces (N&S) made of medium stones (45x23 cm) or medium/little (20x15 cm) and a nucleus made of pale brown soil, little stones and fragments of tiles. The masonry has got an homogeneous structure and it's preserved for 6 courses, built in a sub-brickwork style. The height of 5 courses is 0,86 m; the horizontal joints has a height of 3 cm; the vertical ones are not so evident (1/1,5 cm). This wall was built after breaking the wall 274 and abuts to wall 25.
