APRIL 19 Wednesday AGIABAMPO, SONORA, MEXICO.

This morning hunted along the beach and the mangrove patch and about the ranch. Saw the following birds not seen yesterday. A large flock of White Pelicans, Louisiana Heron, 23, Frazar Oyster Catcher, 44, Least Tern, Red-Backed Sandpiper, Western Sandpiper, (Kriot) 2 among flock of Red-backed Sandpipers, Hudsonian Curlew, Tule Yellowthroat, Barn Swallow, Ground Dove, Parrot 3, Ariz. Hooded Oriole, Wagler Oriole, Douglas Quail, Palmer Thrasher, Cardinal.

In addition to the birds seen this morning, in late afternoon saw Guildded Flicker, Gila Woodpecker, Cactus Wren, an unidentified Hummingbird and Nighthawks were numerous. Two Sylvalagus were seen. A cold windy day.

One or two small bats are flying about our house but so far have eluded all efforts to capture them.

APRIL 20 AGIABAMPO, SONORA, MEXICO.

This morning I hunted about the ranch and then in the small mangrove swamp. A large number of immigrants arrived in the night and I saw the following. Black-headed Grosbeak, Gray Flycatcher, Gray Vireo, Clay colored Sparrow, Green-tailed Towhee, Lutescent Warbler, (Macgillwray) Warbler. Also new to this camp, Ash-throated Flycatcher, Plumbeous Gnatcatcher, Inca Dove, Cactus Woodpecker, Vermillion Flycatcher, Green Heron, Clapper Rail, Ruddy Turnstone, Sanderling, Verdin, and Cliff Swallows.
