

Affidavit


STATEMENT OF FACTS:

At the time the Primate fossil was found in 1997, Jeff Froehlich and I, Allen R. Schmiedicke, thought that we were on BLM Land. We discovered several months later from Charlie Corbett the caretaker for several properties in the valley that the property actually belonged to Richard Milner. Subsequently, in 1998 I and Jeffery Froehlich, obtained verbal permission from Richard Milner to collect and retain fossils from his property in Rio Arriba County New Mexico. This permission to collect and retain fossils included the partially complete lower dentition and small fragments of mandibular bone of a notharctine primate (Eocene; San Jose Formation). In our 1998 meeting with Richard Milner, we told him that we had found the primate and several other fossils and where we had found them. At that time, I gave him a cast of the jaw and he said that he had no problem with us collecting. I also offered to give him the primate fossil material and he refused.
