

## CIIMAR Microbial Culture Collection (CM2C) Terms and Conditions

By accessing content from CIIMAR Microbial Culture Collection (CM2C), including but not limited to all data, documents, and website content and material, the user accepts and agrees to comply these Terms and Conditions:

- A. Intellectual Property:** All content provided by the CM2C (the “Content”)—including but not limited to original data, text, images, audio, video, data, and software presented in multimedia formats and live culture material — are the intellectual property of CIIMAR (Interdisciplinary Centre of Marine and Environmental Research of the University of Porto). CIIMAR retains all rights to the Content, including copyrights, except where copyrights or other proprietary rights are held by other individuals or entities, either exclusively or collaboratively with CIIMAR. To access to data and other content provided by CM2C, that is not eligible for copyright protection, the user is subject upon acceptance of this “Terms and Conditions”.
- B. Limited General License:** The user is not allowed to reproduce, distribute, display, perform, or using the CM2C Content in any manner, except for legitimate, non-commercial or research purpose subjected to previous consent from CIIMAR (“MTA” – Material Transfer Agreement). Copying or redistributing of CM2C Content for commercial use, including commercial publication or for personal benefit, is strictly forbidden without a written consent. In the scope of the Order form or MTA the user agrees to cite properly the **CM2C strain number(s)** in all publications or patent applications and to acknowledge the **CM2C culture collection** as the source of the strains. Users/customers are kindly requested to inform us of any publication including **CM2C strains**.

In addition, Content retrieved from CM2C website and/or CM2C Arctos database should be referenced with website’s/database URL.

This agreement covers CM2C content sourced from Arctos as well as secondary biodiversity information sources such as NCBI, or other. Records from these secondary sources are suitable for data discovery, but should be verified against the CM2C Arctos database, or CM2C website database which contains the most updated information.

- C. Use of Third-Party Content:** Since CM2C Content incorporates the copyrighted material of third parties (“Third-Party Content”), you are only allowed to use the Third-Party Content in agreement with copyright law. CIIMAR does not ensure that any use of Third-Party Content will not infringe the rights of the content owners.
- D. Disclaimer of Warranties/ Limitation of Liability:** CIIMAR provides the Content to the fullest extent permitted by law and disclaims all warranties including express, implied, or other warranties regarding the Content, such as implied warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, and noninfringement. Accessing CM2C Content and/or website is at your own risk. CM2C, CIIMAR or its affiliates, agents, officers, directors, or employees shall not be liable for any damages of any kind arising out of your access to the Content and/or the website, whether in contract, tort, or otherwise.

- E.
