

## DEEP-BioBank Terms of Use

By accessing content from Deep-BioBank, including but not limited to all data, documents, and website content and biological material, the user accepts and agrees to comply with the following Terms of Use:

- A. Intellectual Property:** All materials provided by the Deep-BioBank — including but not limited to original data, text, images, audio, video, data, software presented in multimedia formats and biological material (samples and their derivatives, eg: biosilica)— are intellectual property of CIIMAR (Interdisciplinary Centre of Marine and Environmental Research of the University of Porto). CIIMAR retains all rights to the Content, including copyrights, except where copyrights or other proprietary rights are held by other individuals or entities, either exclusively or collaboratively with CIIMAR. If any data or content made available by Deep-BioBank is not eligible for copyright protection, the user access to such content is contingent upon acceptance of the terms of this “User Agreement”, including the usage restrictions specified below.
- B. Limited General License:** The user is prohibited from reproducing, distributing, displaying, performing, or using the Content in any manner except for legitimate, noncommercial educational or research purposes ("MTA"). Copying or redistributing Deep-BioBank Content in any manner for commercial use, including commercial publication, or for personal benefit, is strictly forbidden without a written consent. When engaging in an Internal requisition/Order form or MTA, the user agrees to cite properly the Deep-BioBank sample code number(s) in all publications or patent applications and to acknowledge the Deep-BioBank collection as the source of the biological material. Users/customers are kindly requested to inform us of any publication including Deep-BioBank’s biological material. In the scope of the Licensed Use, you are obliged to cite properly the Deep-BioBank collection from CIIMAR. In addition, Content retrieved from Deep-BioBank website and/or Deep-BioBank Arctos database should be referenced with website’s URL. This agreement covers Deep-BioBank content sourced from Arctos as well as secondary biodiversity information sources such as NCBI, or other. Records from these secondary sources are suitable for data discovery, but should be verified against the Deep-BioBank Arctos database, or Deep-BioBank website database which contains the most updated information.
- C. Use of Third-Party Content:** Since Deep-BioBank Content incorporates the copyrighted material of third parties (“Third-Party Content”), you are only allowed to use the Third-Party Content in agreement with copyright law. CIIMAR does not ensure that any use of Third-Party Content will not infringe the rights of the content owners.

Disclaimer of Warranties/ Limitation of Liability:** Deep-BioBank provides the data Content free of charge and disclaims all warranties to the fullest extent permitted by law, including express, implied, or other warranties regarding the Content, such as implied warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, and noninfringement.
